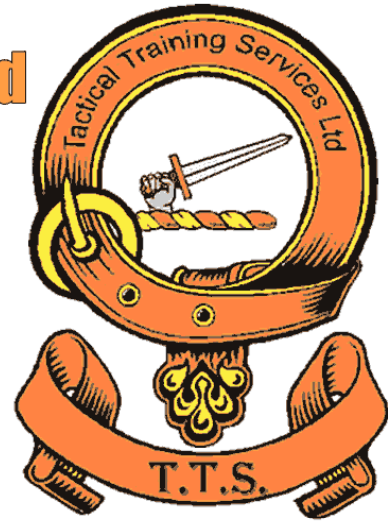

Basic Health & Safety Awareness



This short training awareness course is designed to enable all employees to have a basic understanding of health & safety awareness in the work place.

Duration of Course:

This Basic Health & Safety Awareness course runs for approximately four to seven hours depending on the size of the group.

Aim:

To familiarise and increase the awareness of learners in recognising and controlling potential hazards within their work place.

Objectives:

- Explain and understand the legal duties of an employer, employees and self employed within a work place

- Demonstrate an understanding and awareness of Identify typical risks, hazards and spillages within the workplace, and the measures available to remove or control those hazards
- Understand and explain the process of a risk assessment
- Describe health & safety signs and signals
- Explain the term 'Manual Handling'
- State the precautions to be taken against HIV, Hepatitis and other infectious diseases
- List the items of protective clothing that may be needed within your work place
