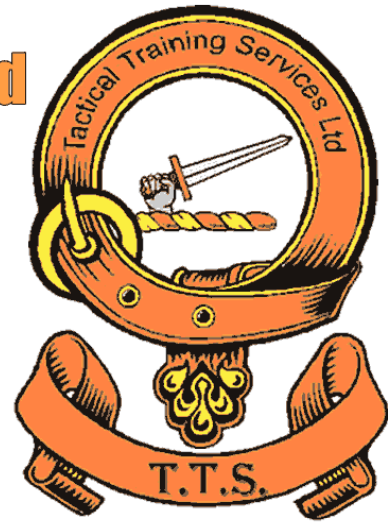

To get the SIA qualification for Door Supervision - Required Training

In order to obtain an SIA licence candidates will need to show that they are trained to the right level.

In setting the standards for training it has been taken into account the changing roles of those already employed in the industry and the requirements for new skills and knowledge.

The training includes conflict management and communication, which have been identified as basic skills needed by the industry.

To get the SIA qualification for door supervisors, you will need to attend a two part training course and take and pass two examinations.

The course may be delivered over 4 days or during weekends and / or evening sessions. The total training time will always be 30 hours, which includes two hours of exams.

Training is delivered in two parts as follows:

- Part 1 - Role and responsibilities of a door supervisor (14 hours)
- Part 2 - Communication skills and conflict management (14 hours)
